*A windmill is a structure that converts the energy of wind into rotational energy by means of vanes (called sails or blades).*

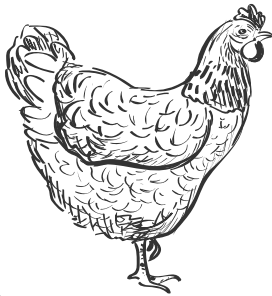


### CHICKEN FOOTPRINTS

*Chickens experience REM sleep - which means they are capable of dreaming. What do you think chickens dream about?*

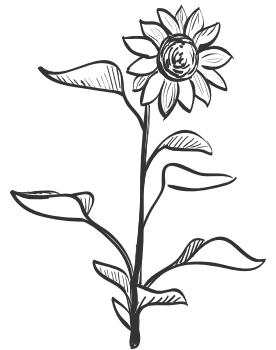


### MILK BOTTLES

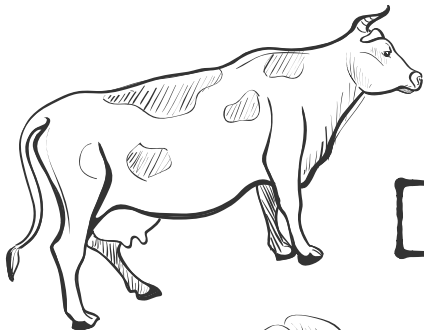


### PAINTED COW
